



SECONDARY SCHOOL OUTREACH PROGRAMME – *FROM THE MOUNTAINS TO THE SEA*

For Secondary 1 to 7 students
September 2010 to August 2011

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From the Mountains to the Sea is a nature-themed exhibition pack developed in accordance with the curriculum of Liberal Studies. The virtual journey from the mountains to the sea showcases the beauty of the transition of natural habitats and biodiversity in Hong Kong. This exhibition helps students understand the anthropogenic threats and the interactions between the natural environment and socio-economic development. Students will be motivated to reflect the importance of nature conservation and sustainable development at large.

A. INTRODUCTION

The exhibition pack was specially designed to raise secondary school students' interest and concern about Hong Kong's natural environment. The exhibition pack includes:

1. Exhibition Set

The set contains 11 full colour panels [A1 size (83 cm x 58 cm)] featuring fantastic illustrations of the transition of natural environment (upland shrublands, *fung shui* woods, hill streams, mangroves, intertidal mudflats, sandy shores, rocky shores and coral communities) and vivid photographic records of a rich array of flora and fauna in Hong Kong.

2. Glossary and Game Card (hard and soft copies)

Selected glossary is provided on a handy card to aid students' interpretation while reading the panel. On the other side of the card, an animal-to-habitat matching game is designed to challenge students' understanding of the content.

3. Worksheets (hard and soft copies)

Three pages of ready-to-use worksheets are included in the pack to assist teachers in assessing the learning outcome of students.

B. EDUCATION APPROACH

All the contents of the *From the Mountains to the Sea* are presented in either Chinese or English to suit teachers' need. All the illustrations, artwork and panel layout design are created by professional illustrators and designers.
