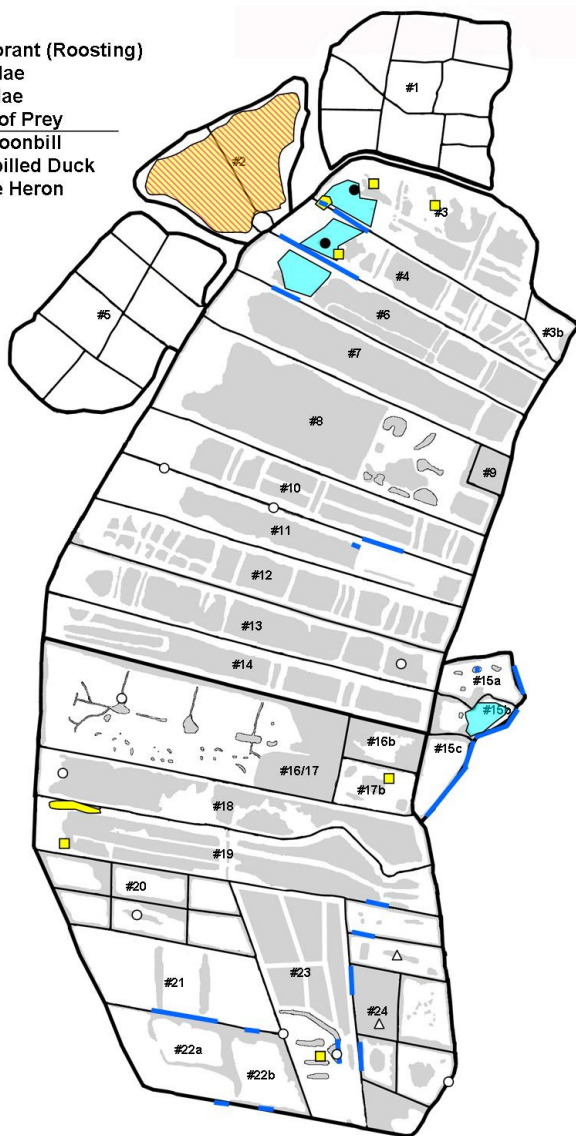

Counting at Pond #15 carried out after supplementary feeding.
