



零廢露營大作戰



試想想，你置身於一個優美的自然環境，鳥語花香，本應令人心曠神怡。但放眼一看竟發現遍地垃圾，你享受嗎？現時，在香港的郊野公園特別是露營地點中，不難在垃圾箱及回收箱以外找到被棄置的廢物。這些廢物不單污染環境，更令野生動物有機會從中覓食，損害動物健康和生態。因此，我們將會進行「三日兩夜零廢遠足露營挑戰」並以影片記錄過程和感受，親身體驗零廢露營的可行性，為大眾提供可行的零廢遠足小貼士。此外，我們亦會訪問正在使用郊野公園的遊客，了解大眾對零廢遠足的看法。如果你也是遠足或露營愛好者，請密切留意我們的零廢遠足露營挑戰！

Let's imagine, can you enjoy a natural, spectacular scenery which is filled with unpleasant, stinking cans and plastics? The answer is likely NO. Unfortunately, it may not be difficult to spot pieces of litter in country parks, especially in camping sites. Litter in the wild not only contaminates the environment but also can alter the natural behavior of wild animals as they might look for food from trash. Hence, we would like to take up a "Three-day Zero-Waste Camping Challenge" to experience the possibility of camping without producing leftovers. A video will be produced after the camping including our campaign to promote the idea of protecting the environment, encouraging people to bring their litter back to the city for recycling, but not to leave them in the wild. Besides, we will do an interview with those users of country parks to investigate their opinions on zero-Waste Camping and hiking. If you are hiking and camping lovers, please stay tuned with us!
