“Marine Ranger” Programme Rundown

MARINE RANGER is a Centre-based “Education for Sustainable Development” Programme specially designed for secondary school students. By conducting field visit on the beach, marine litter survey and coastal cleanup activities, students can understand the globally concerned marine litter problem. They will be encouraged to think about their impacts of living habits towards the environment.



Programme Content: The 4-hour programme will be conducted in action-based learning approach including field visit, marine life observation and marine litter survey. This programme also include **Glass-bottomed Boat trip for coral observation** (weather dependent).

Students need to walk along a hiking path to approach the study site, it takes around 15-20mins. Please remind students to wear suitable shirts and shoes.

** Teacher in-charge should lead the students to walk back to the Hoi Ha Village Coach Drop Off Point after the visit, it takes around 15 mins.
